Meadfleet Walkabout - Spring 2019

With: Emlyn Craven, Regional Manager Meadfleet and FHVRA (Scott Roberts & Martin Dower) on 2nd April 2019

Aims: Review phase 2 handover and progress on phase 1 items

Walked the village, reviewing the existing Phase 1 maintenance, noting some of the improvements made to beds and borders plus an outline of what's outstanding.


- Seeding the drainage construction work in the park (DWH)
- Replenishing soft bark and improving slide landing zone (MF)
- Fixing wall at top of park (MF)
- Establish the plan for the "wild steep area" just behind the top side of Fountainhead road. (DWH/MF)
- Addition of wild flowers, bulbs and general planting is planned within the scope of the existing maintenance contract - there is a cost for materials (MF)
- The state of dog fouling in the park was raised by MF and it was suggested a "dogs always on leads" policy introduced and getting the council involved to prosecute offenders. Need to discuss the options and create a plan (FHVRA: MD)
- Agreement for the future of the ghost site on Fountainhead Road. Site needs tidying up and opening up to allow access (DWH)
- Confirmed appointment of a local contractor (Elite Garden Maintenance of Ovenden) as new "Soft Landscape Contractor" starting April (MF)
- Phase 2 handover process starts in April between DWH and MF with Emlyn and Steve Corcoran doing the first walk-around where Emlyn will highlight the areas that need to be addressed before MF will take them over. (MF/ DWH)
- The projected increase in management cost per house after the phase 2 handover will be £2pm (£25pa). Emlyn is to provide a scope of the Phase 2 additional work (the areas it covers is attached elsewhere). Increased frequency of visits seemed to be part of this (MF)
- The Bat House was discussed, MF explained we'd need ordered demolition after approval from planning (FHVRA: SK)
- Phase 3 was touched on but discussions were set aside for later on this year. (TBC)
- The roundabout on Fountainhead road was discussed, including the option of planting water consuming trees. Subsequently this was objected to by the immediate neighbours (FHVRA: SR)

Paths and Pavements

FHVRA sought clarification of where the responsibility for maintenance for paths and were advised that **none** of the paths or pavements were covered by MF, they were the responsibility of the DWH, the council and/or individual home owners. Broken steps and damaged paths therefore need reporting to the council via https://www.calderdale.gov.uk/transport/roads/request-report/ report-pot-hole.html We suspect there is more to this situation than meets the eye as we have had conflicting advice and communications previously plus MF have in the past repaired them

Recommendations/Actions

- Attend the DWH/MF phase 2 walk-around (FHVRA: ?? pending date)
- Start a centrally-managed FHVRA management snagging list that residents can add to (FHVRA: JT)
- Roll-in previous walk-around notes (FHVRA: MD)
- Dog Fouling discussion at the next committee meeting (FHVRA: ALL)
- Walk-arounds every 3 months to review progress and highlight new issues (ALL)
- Publish a revised scope of works (FHVRA: JT)
- Resolve ownership and responsibility for every pathway in the village (FHVRA: JT/SK)
- Discuss shared driveways and walls (FHVRA/DWH/MF)
- Publish Phase 2 map on website green areas (FHVRA: MD)
- Publish walkabout notes on website (FHVRA: MD) and FB (SR)
