- 3. Steps in the upper park have been replaced with new at a cost of £3.5k (or about £13 per household) to include additional playground works to bring it up to an acceptable standard. We have been assured that they should "last a long time".
- 4. EVENT: Xmas '23 Planning Started: SR to lead with help from others as and when required.
- 5. Banking: Account transfer documents signed to allow JC access to the bank and remove non-committee members
- 6. Council management role passed back to SR
- 7. **EVENT:** MF have offered a (free) Bat Walk with their ecology manager. MD to contact and set a date for a family evening event over the summer holidays
- 8. Community Noticeboard to be updated with new signage and more frequent changes of content including posting about meetings. Keys need to be recovered (SR) to MD
- 9. The New Development on Maltings Road was raised. The questions revolve around vehicular access and the addition of 31 new homes increases the village size by 10% hence its less about traffic volume but about quality of roads including the width, specifically for wider vehicles inc the bus service. Task SR/MD as part of the planned post-handover Council Walkaround.
- We were asked about MF (actually Elite) policy of grass "cut and drop" vs "cut and collect".
 MD to raise on the next MF walkaround due over the Summer.
- 11. Remove the old "Malting Site" signs from the top of Malting Road (SK)
- 12. Other council issues: Dog Poo signs, overhanging trees, bins, wild animal signs, winter grit, and flooding outside Yew Tree farm will all be dealt with on the council walkaround.
